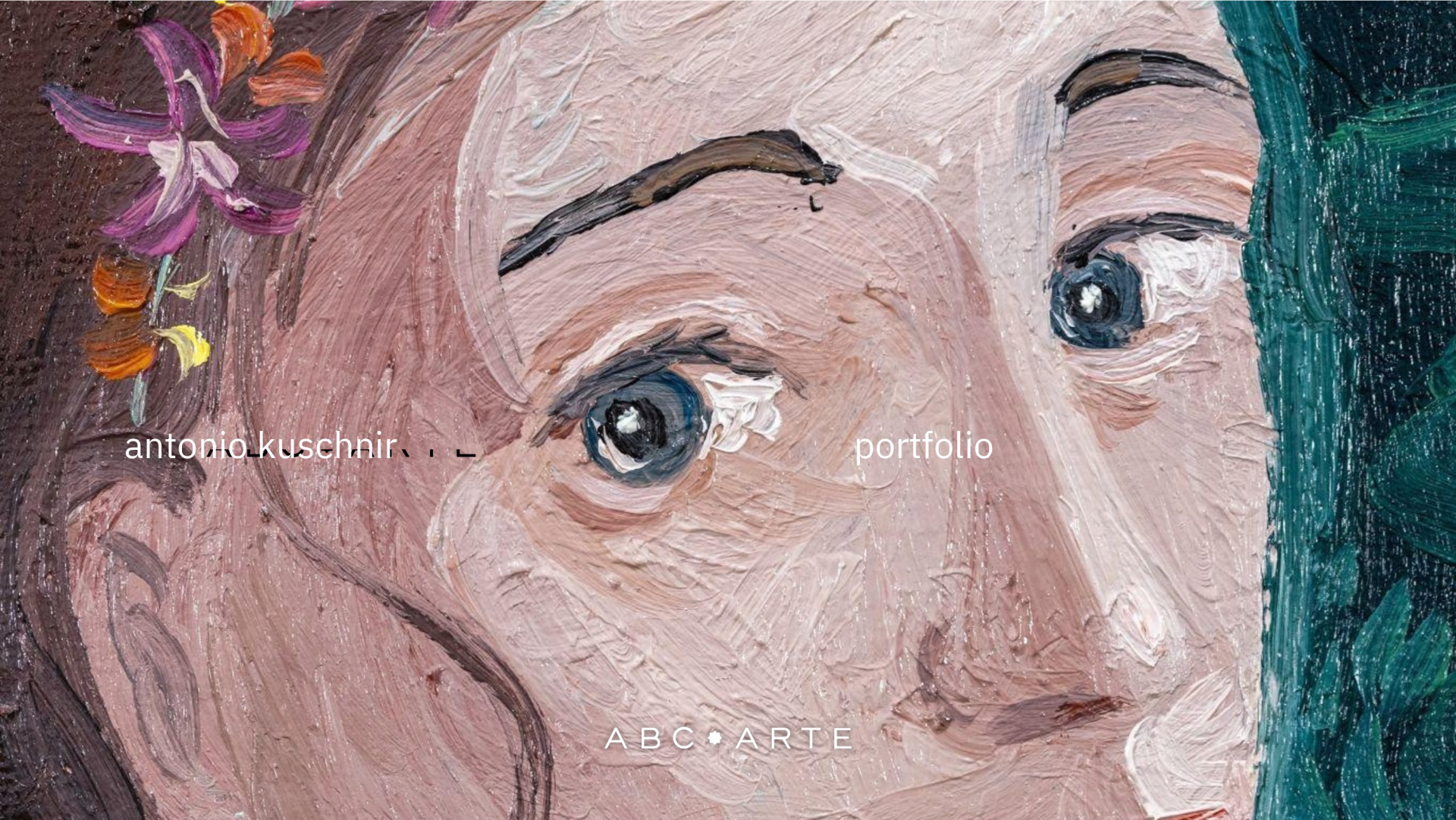

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Antonio Kuschnir (b. 2001, Rio de Janeiro) is a Brazilian artist who lives and works between Bonn and Rio de Janeiro. Rooted in painting, his practice draws on art history, myth, autobiography, and collective memory to construct densely populated pictorial worlds. Human figures, animals, and hybrid beings inhabit spaces in which the intimate becomes archetypal and the familiar slips into the strange. Narrative remains present but never fixed: bodies merge with ornament, space shifts, and scenes of apparent harmony are unsettled by undercurrents of tension and ambiguity.

Kuschnir holds a bachelor's degree in Painting from the Escola de Belas Artes at the Universidade Federal do Rio de Janeiro (EBA/UFRJ). Selected solo exhibitions include *Arcádia Incerta*, ABC-ARTE ONE OF, Milan (2026); *O mundo entreaberto*, WG Galeria, São Paulo (2026); *O Canto do Rio*, ABC-ARTE, Genoa (2025); *Donde florece lo salvaje*, Baró Galeria, Palma de Mallorca (2025); and *Choro*, Museu de Arte Contemporânea de Niterói (MAC Niterói, 2022), where he became the youngest artist to occupy the museum's main exhibition hall. In 2025, he completed residencies at La Napoule Art Foundation, France, and CCA Andratx, Spain. His first monographic catalogue, *O Canto do Rio*, was published by ABC-ARTE that same year.

His work is held in the collections of the Museu de Arte do Rio (MAR), the Presidency of Brazil, the Museu de Arte Contemporânea de Niterói (MAC Niterói), and the Centro Cultural da Diversidade in São Paulo.
