## Jerry Zeniuk

Nato nel 1945 in Bardowick bei Luneburg (DE), figlio di un rifugiato ucraino, emigra insieme ai suoi genitori negli Stati Uniti nel 1950, dove cresce in Colorado.

Dopo gli studi si trasferisce nel 1969 a New York, dove tiene la sua prima mostra personale presso la galleria Paley & Lowe nel 1972.

Risiede stabilmente dagli anni Settanta a Monaco di Baviera, dove lavora con la Konrad Fischer Galerie a Dusseldorf e Berlino, e con la galleria Annemarie Verna di Zurigo.

La Pittura di Zeniuk è apprezzata a partire dagli anni Settanta, da quando egli partecipa alla memorabile mostra collettiva del 1975 intitolata Fundamental Painting, allo Stedelijk Museum di Amsterdam. Zeniuk sviluppa in quel periodo i suoi lavori su un piano monocromo, in cui diversi strati di colore sono sovrapposti attraverso una composizione di piani di cromatici contrastanti accostati.

Nel 1977 prende parte a Documenta 6 a Kassel e nel 1999 il Museo Lenbachhaus di Monaco di Baviera gli dedica una retrospettiva, così come il Kunstmuseum di Winterthur e il Kunstmuseum di Kassel.

Nella Pittura di Jerry Zeniuk il Colore è un aspetto fondamentale, e la Bellezza, fisica e visiva, è il fine da raggiungere. Secondo Zeniuk i colori non sono solo portatori di emozioni, ma la loro interazione è in grado di riflettere anche le relazioni sociali e, più in generale, umane.

I suoi lavori più recenti presentano cerchi colorati o punti o forme che creano interazioni tese a generare uno specifico spazio pittorico. Questi segni galleggiano su una tela imbiancata o grezza, e lasciano presagire uno spazio in cui la luce è trattenuta. I contorni di questi punti sono in alcuni casi netti, in altri più tenui ed atmosferici, portati in un armonioso equilibrio che genera un deciso effetto spaziale.

Dal 1992 al 2010 è professore presso la Akademie der Bildende Künste a Monaco di Baviera.

Nel 1999 il Museo Lenbachhaus di Monaco di Baviera gli ha dedicato una retrospettiva, così come il Kunstmuseum di Winterthur e il Kunstmuseum di Kassel. Nel 2004 anche la Kunsthalle di Karlsruhe gli dedica una retrospettiva. Negli anni più recenti i suoi lavori sono esibiti inoltre presso importanti istituzioni pubbliche come il Museo Augsburg, il Museo Wiesbaden, il Kunstmuseum di Bonn, la Kunsthalle di Brema, Kunsthalle di Amburgo, il Louisiana Museum, lo Staatliche Museen di Humlebaek, la Neue Galerie, la Kassel Pfalzgalerie, il Kaiserslautern Museum Ludwig, il Bayerische Staatsgemäldesammlungen di Colonia, la Städtische Galerie im Lenbachhaus di Monaco, la Sammlung Niedersächsische Sparkassenstiftung di Monaco, il Virginia Museum of Fine Arts a Richmond, la The Maslow Collection di Shaverton.

**Jerry Zeniuk** was born in 1945 in Bardowick, on the then inner border between East and West Germany, as a son of Ukrainian refugees. In 1950 his family emigrated to the United States, settling in a small town called Loveland, Colorado. After completing an MFA (Master in Fine Art) in Painting at the University of Colorado Boulder, Zeniuk moved to New York City, where the Paley & Lowe gallery in 1972 held his first solo show. Soon a number of important international exhibitions followed, as for example *Geplante Malerei*, Westfälischer Kunstverein Münster, Germany, in 1974. More importantly, Zeniuk's work was shown in the groundbreaking show *Fundamental Painting* at the Stedelijk Museum Amsterdam in the Netherlands in 1975, which defined contemporary minimalist painting on both sides of the Atlantic. It was followed by the equally important *I Colori della Pittura. Una Situazione Europea* at the Istituto Italo-Latino-American in Rome, Italy, *Bilder ohne Bilder* at the Rheinisches Landesmuseum, Bonn, Germany, and *Abstraction Analytique* at the ARC-Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris, Paris, France; and his work was part of the iconic 1977 *Documenta 6* in Kassel, Germany.

Currently, Zeniuk lives in Munich, Germany, where he taught painting at the Academy of Fine Art from 1992 to his retirement in 2010. The Konrad Fischer Gallery in both Düsseldorf and Berlin as well as Annemarie Verna, Zurich, and Slewe Galerie in Amsterdam, Netherlands, regularly display his works. In 1999 his first large-scale traveling retrospective was shown by the Städtische Galerie im Lenbachhaus, Munich, and the Neue Galerie, Kassel, Germany, as well as the Kunstmuseum Winterthur, Switzerland, accompanied by a first comprehensive catalogue of his lifetime work. It was followed by a 2004 retrospective of watercolors at the Staatliche Kunsthalle Karlsruhe, Germany. Zeniuk's works have been exhibited by innumerable museums and are held in a number of important collections around the world, as for example the Museum Wiesbaden, Germany, Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, Humblebaek, Denmark, the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts and The Maslow Collection, Shaverton, PA, in the USA. From 2022 he's represented in Italy by ABC-ARTE gallery.

Zeniuk's lifetime work is an in-depth research into the fundamentals of painting, mainly through color. His early works made an attempt at defining painting by way of monochromatic planes executed in encaustic and reflective pigments in neutral colors that created a very shallow sense of space; the painting encountered the viewer on a human scale like a neutral *alter ego* talking about its nature as a painting. His recent works are composed of colored dots that are firmly anchored in the painted plane and that are related both to each other and their viewer by way of their hues. They reflect a wide range of emotions and social interactions. For Zeniuk, who majored in History, Philosophy and Art, absolute beauty is an incontestable part of painting.
